

Instructions for Baby Cap

Use baby yarn and a set of 4 needles or circular knitting needles, No. 10 (3.25 mm).

Cast on 70 stitches. (If using 4 needles, 24, 24, 22.)

Band: K1, P1 for 1 ½ inches.

Next Row: Knit all around three needles. Continue for three to four inches in this manner.

Next Row: (Knit 8, Knit 2 together) all around. Knit one row.

Next Row: (Knit 7, Knit 2 together) all around. Knit one row.

Next Row: (Knit 6, Knit 2 together) all around. Knit one row.

Next Row: (Knit 5, Knit 2 together) all around. Knit one row.

Next Row: (Knit 4, Knit 2 together) all around. Knit one row.

Next Row: (Knit 3, Knit 2 together) all around. Knit one row.

Next Row: (Knit 2, Knit 2 together) all around. Knit one row.

Next Row: (Knit 1, Knit 2 together) all around. Knit one row.

Next Row: Knit 2 together all around remaining stitches. Thread yarn through remaining stitches. Draw up and fasten securely.

Pneumonia Vests

2 oz. 4 ply soft yarn, 2 needles No. 8 or 9 Cdn. (4 or 3 ¾ mm)

Cast on 60 stitches. (All knitting is in garter stitch.)

Knit 90 rows or 10 inches.

Next Row: Knit 20 stitches, put on holder. Cast off next 20. Knit remaining stitches until 3 inches long. Put on holder. Put stitches from first holder on needles and knit to the same length.

Next Row: Knit 20 stitches, cast on 20 stitches, knit 20 stitches on holder.

Knit 90 rows or 10 inches. Cast off. Sew up sides, leaving three inches for arm holes.

Preemie Size:

Cast on 48 stitches. Knit length to 9 inches. Use 16 stitches for shoulders. Otherwise, do the same.
